Lunchtime Enrichment Clubs

These clubs have been going really well, it's all change this term as the children have all moved to different clubs. It's a great opportunity for them to have a turn at trying new experiences.



























Class 1 – this term the project has been Dinosaur Island, looking at how to study evidence of the past, including names of dinosaurs, their diets and habitats as well as their breeding habits. Children have also continued working on literacy and maths and studying the artist Van Gogh and recreating his artwork in the same style.























Class 2 - Children have been studying the artist Paul Klee's work and making their own replicas, together with the artist Heather Gailer. They have been learning about the UK in geography and about multiplication in maths.



Class 3 - children have been taking part in ukulele lessons, they have been designing, sketching, building and evaluating a musical instrument. In PE Improving their basic striking and fielding skills, as well as learning about collage, symmetry, and the paintings of LS Lowry art. They have been planting seeds in gardening club too.



Class 4 - Children have been learning about the Earth and other planets, investigating light and shadows. They have studied the artist Peter Thorpe in the design, style and techniques. They have also been learning about the values of 'Truthfulness and Dignity' in R.E.
